How we got started

Outcome from Dec. 5 Open SUNY Interest Group:

Develop guidelines for and a platform to facilitate locating of shareable and adaptable IL content among SUNY professionals in the form of a portal / repository.

Rationale

- A. Central locations for best practices
- B. Items scalable (i.e., system or localized)
- C. Encourages and facilitates community and communication (SUNYLA and WGIL)
- D. Fosters collaboration and reduces duplication of effort in creating content and identifying content needed
- E. Creates a transparent experience across campuses and types of sessions
- F. Facilitates assessment of the effectiveness of IL content across campuses
